New England Aquarium + Whale Watch

Explore New England's rich marine life on this trip! New England is known for its coasts and sea life, and there's no better way to spend the day in Boston than experiencing it from the land and sea! Have the adventure of a lifetime taking a whale watching boat to Stellwagen Bank Marine Sanctuary, a rich feeding ground for whales, dolphins, seabirds and other marine creatures. Stellwagen is home to many species of large whales, including humpbacks, finbacks and minkes, and the critically endangered right whales. New England Aquarium naturalists will share knowledge, answer your questions and explain the fascinating behaviors of these truly magnificent mammals. Afterwards, visit the New England Aquarium where you will see their incredible four-story giant ocean tank filled with 2,000 species of fish, and even get up close and personal with a shark at the aquarium touch tank.

Museum of Science + Duck Boat Tour

Voted Boston's Most Popular Tour for several years, on this trip you'll see many of Boston's historic sites including Faneuil Hall and Boston Common. Blue Man Group + Newbury St (July 5 Only)
